Visit the restored home of rebel publisher William Lyon Mackenzie and experience 500 years of printing technology including the Louis Roy Press, the oldest in Canada and one of the few original wooden presses remaining in the world! Then travel back in time to the lovingly restored home of Laura Secord, Canada's Most Famous Heroine. Finish the evening with fresh Mediterranean cuisine inspired by the Tuscan countryside, traditionally prepared and served in the heart of Niagara-on-the-Lake. (Depart 4:30 p.m.; return 9:30 p.m.)
